In 2018, the NIH Single IRB (sIRB) Policy went into effect, requiring NIH-funded multi-site research to utilize a single IRB of record. The Institutional Review Board (IRB) Reliance Exchange (IREx) is a freely available. NIH-supported web-based platform supporting sIRBs, lead study teams (LST), and relying sites (HRPPs and study teams) through the complex sIRB process for the life of the study.

- Over 40 different sIRBs using IREx
- Over 650 studies
- 500+ sites
- · 3700+ reliance decisions
- 29.000+ site approvals documented

METHODS

Users were asked to complete satisfaction surveys in Q2 of 2023

WHO to survey

- sIRB: Primary Contact listed on the study
- Relying HRPP: Relying HRPP contact who signed the HRP Survey
- LST/Study Manager (SM): most active memberbased a) email interactions or b) the person listed most frequently in the log
- We did not contact potential respondents >2 times, even if they were eligible

WHEN to survey IREx users

- sIRBs: after lead site approval posted to IREx
- LST/SMs: after ~25% of their participating sites received initial approval
- Relying HRPPs: after receiving initial approval on a

- Utilization continues to grow annually, both in the number of new sIRBs that use IREx for the first time and number of studies created in the platform each year
- 5/9 feature suggestions from open text fields have already been addressed and others are being worked on








- 1. Better document what activities are happening at each site
- 2. Continue to capture whether the site has differences from the protocol




3. Allow sites to denote that they are engaged due to affiliations/institutional relations, but have not activities at their site.

Export Institutional Profile as CSV:After logging into IREx





IREx Now Supports Studies with EFIC!

- 3. Provide sites with clear EFIC processes and approval statuses






Upload Community Consultation Plan (CCP) Template








Lead Study Team Uploads CCP Acceptance from sIRB





Status Summary: After CCP Accepted




After CCP implementation, Study Team Uploads CCP Summary of Results




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
- 92% of sites in IREx have completed their Institutional Profile
- 88% of IREx sites have indicated reliance
- 88% of sites have ceded review and have approval posted to IREx
- 34 out of 46 single IRBs are using IREx for more than one study
- 12 median days from initial sIRB submission to sIRB approval for relying sites (not including local review time)

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- 517 unique participating sites
- 4263 total reliances across all studies
- 7 sites per study on average
- 85% of studies created after 2018 collecting local considerations
- 33 days between lead site initial approval to submission (median)

IREX Checks for related IREx IP Questions

- State and local laws that establish age of majority
- Institutional policies that affect any applicable assent process
- Community Info (e.g., Populations likely to be enrolled at a site or by a study team that could affect the assent process, such as in terms of language, religious or cultural consideration)
